Scope of Works:

Szerelmey Conservation have completed extensive restoration and repair works to the Church of the Good Shepherd, Carshalton Beeches. This is a Grade II listed building which was built in 1930 by Martin Travers and TFW Grant, and is often described as being in the “Spanish Mission” style.

The scope of works undertaken including widespread brick repairs and replacements to the façade and extensive repointing. The joints were carefully raked out before being repointed with appropriate mortar. In addition we carried out repair work to the flat roofing and high level repair works, in addition to the repair and replacement of flashings and asphalt.
